

PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

GRADE 8

1. Use checkpoint results as guideline.
2. If a student achieves below 40% for English, the student needs to repeat grade 8.
3. If a student fails Mathematics, 50% or less, the student can be promoted conditionally if he/she takes core level Mathematics.

If the student would like to continue with extended mathematics, he/she needs to repeat grade 8.

4. If a student fails English and three other subjects, the student needs to repeat grade 8.
5. All other subjects – if a student achieves 40% or below for these subjects he/she will not be allowed to carry on with this particular subject in grade 9.

GRADE 9

1. If a student achieves below 50% or below for English or Mathematics he/she may have to repeat grade 9. However students who have made considerable progress during the course of the year maybe given the opportunity to haul in the short fall in the remaining 9 months of the IGCSE course.

GRADE 10

HESA and Cambridge requirements are very important.

All Group 5 subjects at Cambridge International AS Level are only recognised if the student has passed IGCSE Mathematics with a minimum of grade C.
