Please note:

1. A once off **Application Fee** of R750.00 is payable for applications to Grades 0000 to A Levels.
2. **Registration fee** is a once off fee of **R4 000.00**, payable on registration and is non-refundable. There is no discount on Registration Fees.
3. School fees are payable by the 7th of each month.
4. For registering 2 (or more) children: 5% discount on the amount payable for the second child or 10% discount on the amount payable for the third child on the **current annual school fee amount** onwards.

5. Should one or more of the children be granted a scholarship, the above-mentioned discounts will not apply.
6. Discount on **full payment** (in advance) of Annual School Fee:
 Before 30 November 2021, pay the 2021 school fee for 2022.
 Before 31 December 2021, 4.5% discount on 2022 fee.
 Discount will not apply where the child has been granted a scholarship.
7. Full Time Alma Mater Primary- and High School students do not pay for extra lessons organised and taught by Alma Mater staff.
8. Excluded from school fees are transport, stationery, study guides, school uniforms, text- and exercise books, camps, excursions, tours, School Magazine, Matric Farewell and Valentines Ball.
9. Exam fees are only for Grades 7, 10 and 12. Exam fees are subject to prevailing exchange rate (GBP £) at time of payment and no discount is applicable on exam fees.
10. Reprinting of School Reports: R200.00 per report.

ADDITIONAL FEES FOR PRE- AND PRIMARY SCHOOL

A standardised amount will be invoiced per grade. A detailed list per grade will be published. Please note: The amount differs per grade:

1. **Textbook list** (To be purchased through the school's official supplier, Itzy Stationers <https://itzy.co.za>, or a supplier of your choice before **end of November**) *
2. **School Pack** (This is compulsory; it will be invoiced per student with the description "School Pack")

 Students will be issued with most of the items on the first day of school and the balance throughout the year, as needed. This also includes all on-line licensing fees etc.)
3. **Stationery list** (Can be purchased through a supplier of your choice and per student's needs)
4. **School Readiness Assessment:** Gr R students going to Grade 1
 This is compulsory for admission to Grade 1. You can use a therapist of your choice as your Medical Aid may cover the cost. Please contact Admissions for a list of Therapists.

Please note:

- 1. The enrolment fee is payable on registration and non-refundable. There is no discount on Registration Fees.*
- 2. Weekly boarding will allow a student to board for up to four nights a week (Monday to Thursday only).*
- 3. Weekly boarders will be allowed only two weekend stays per term. Prior arrangements need to be made with the House Parents. The fee per weekend stay in is **R300.00** per night.*
- 4. Boarding fees include overnight accommodation, meals, linen, and laundry services for agreed nights.*
- 5. Boarding fees do not include normal curriculum tuition, co-curricular activities, and extra academic assistance.*
- 6. Holiday School and Easter Holiday fees are not included in the termly or weekly boarding fees.*

Additional Expenses

- 1. Voluntary activities are organised by various members of staff and charges are made per the activity e.g., concerts, theatre trips and outdoor expeditions.*
- 2. Unavoidable Expenses (Items such as those listed below are invoiced on the termly invoice): Examination fees; Additional trips and visits; Stationery; magazine subscriptions and lost textbooks.*
