### Weekly Boarding

4 nights per week; closed for April, August, and December holidays and *excludes tuition and transport fees*

### Termly Boarding

7 nights per week; closed for April, August, and December holidays and *excludes tuition and transport fees*

### Please note:

1. The enrolment fee is payable on registration and non-refundable. There is no discount on Registration Fees.
2. Weekly boarding will allow a student to board for up to four nights a week (Monday to Thursday only).
3. Weekly boarders will be allowed only two weekend stays per term. Prior arrangements need to be made with the House Parents. The fee per weekend stay is **R350.00** per night.
4. Boarding fees include overnight accommodation, meals, linen, and laundry services for agreed nights.
5. Boarding fees do not include normal curriculum tuition, co-curricular activities, and extra academic assistance.
6. Holiday School and Easter Holiday fees are not included in the termly or weekly boarding fees.

### Additional Expenses

1. Voluntary activities are organised by various members of staff and charges are made per activity e.g., concerts, theatre trips and outdoor excursions.
2. Unavoidable Expenses (Items such as those listed below are invoiced on the termly invoice): Examination fees; Additional trips and visits; Stationery; magazine subscriptions and lost textbooks.
3. The insurance policies of Alma Mater **do not** cover the loss of students' personal belongings.
